


Memorandum of Understanding between EHC and WFH


The World Federation of Hemophilia (WFH) represents the interest of National Member Organizations (NMOs) in 101 countries worldwide. The European Hemophilia Consortium (EHC) is a consortium of 43 European hemophilia societies including all countries within the European Union (EU) and the majority of those in the Council of Europe.

1. This Memorandum of Understanding specifies the modalities of co-operation between WFH and EHC to optimise the impact of our work to improve the welfare of persons with hemophilia in Europe.
2. WFH recognizes EHC as a separate entity of European NMOs while recognizing that EHC is a constituent of the WFH. EHC membership rules follow WFH membership rules, as the 43 EHC hemophilia societies are WFH NMOs (as per EHC Constitution).
3. WFH will continue to represent the view of the global hemophilia community on regulations, guidelines and directives from all regions and regulatory authorities.
4. WFH actively encourages EHC to represent the views of NMOs in the EU and the Council of Europe on EU guidelines and directives and on Council of Europe recommendations. WFH will assist EHC to develop and strengthen its monitoring capability when it is within WFH's power to do so.
5. EHC will continue its activities such as its annual meeting and other activities as it chooses. WFH will continue its program activities (country programs, twinnings, fellowships, training, product donations etc). It is agreed that these activities will not be duplicated.
6. WFH will continue to collect annual data from all countries and will copy the data received from European countries to EHC. If EHC collects specific data from European countries, EHC will copy it to WFH.
7. WFH is happy to continue hosting the EHC website as long as it is mutually agreed.
8. It is recognized that EHC is responsible for its own fundraising and financial viability with the proviso that EHC will not seek funding from pharmaceutical companies for programs or activities that would duplicate those of WFH.




