Call for volunteers to join the European Rare and Inhibitor Network (ERIN) Committee

Dear NMOs,

The European Haemophilia Consortium (EHC) is currently looking for up to ten (10) volunteers to join the European Rare and Inhibitor Network (ERIN) Committee for a period of three years (2023-2025).

The aim of the committee is to create awareness, recognition, support and education about and for people with inhibitors and extremely rare bleeding disorders in Europe, both internally within the EHC and its community, as well as externally amongst broader stakeholders.

The EHC is currently looking for:

- Up to ten volunteers who either are affected by a bleeding disorder or are healthcare providers of bleeding disorders.

The ideal candidate will:

- Be members of or have a strong professional link with one of the EHC National Member Organisations (NMO),
- Be fluent in English,
- Committed to dedicating sufficient time to fulfil the activities required by the group, including on short notice and with a tight deadline
- Have experience at either national or international level in carrying out activities and representing people with inhibitors and extremely rare bleeding disorders in the bleeding disorder community.

To apply for this position, candidates will need to send:

- The candidate's CV, outlining in particular relevant experience such as volunteering,
- A motivation letter outlining briefly their background and why they are interested in joining the ERIN Committee,


- For the patient representatives, a letter of recommendation from the NMO President outlining why they believe the candidate would make a great addition to the ERIN Committee.
