Call for volunteers to join the EHC Non-severe Bleeding Disorders Committee

Dear NMOs,

The European Haemophilia Consortium (EHC) is currently looking for four-eight volunteers to join its newly established Non-severe Bleeding Disorders Committee for a period of three years (2023-2025).

This committee has been established to create awareness, recognition, support and education about and for people with non-severe bleeding disorders in Europe, both internally within the EHC and its community, as well as externally amongst broader stakeholders.

The EHC is currently looking for:

- Four-eight volunteers who either have a bleeding disorder or are healthcare providers of bleeding disorders.

The ideal candidate will:

- Be members of or have a strong professional link with one of the EHC National Member Organisations (NMO),
- Be fluent in English,
- Committed to dedicating sufficient time to fulfil the activities required by the group, including on short notice and with a tight deadline
- Have experience at either national or international level in carrying out activities and representing the non-severe in the bleeding disorder community.

To apply for this position, candidates will need to send:

- The candidate's CV, outlining in particular relevant experience such as volunteering,
- A motivation letter outlining briefly their background and why they are interested in joining the EHC Non-severe Bleeding Disorders Committee,
- A letter of recommendation from the NMO President outlining why they believe the
