Call for volunteers to join the EHC Women and Bleeding Disorders Committee

Dear NMOs,

The European Haemophilia Consortium (EHC) is currently looking for six volunteers to join its newly established Women and Bleeding Disorders Committee for a period of three years (2020-2022).

This committee has been established to create awareness, recognition, support and education about, and for, women in the bleeding disorder community at European level. The committee will provide advice to EHC members, volunteers and staff in matters concerning women with bleeding disorders.

The EHC is currently looking for:

- Six volunteers who either have a bleeding disorder or relative/caregiver of a person with a bleeding disorder.

The ideal candidate will:

- Be members of or have a strong professional link with one of the EHC National Member Organisations (NMO),
- Be fluent in English,
- Commit to dedicate enough time to fulfil the activities carried out by the WBD Committee. The estimated time needed is one hour per week, plus one hour online meeting per month, plus one full day face-to-face meeting per year. The workload may require the ability to work on short notice and to meet tight deadlines.
- Have experience at either national or international level in carrying out activities and representing women in the bleeding disorder community.

To apply for this position, candidates will need to send:

- The candidate's CV, outlining in particular relevant experience such as volunteering,
- A motivation letter outlining briefly their background and why they are interested in joining

- A letter of recommendation from the NMO President outlining why they believe the candidate would make a great addition to the EHC Women and Bleeding Disorders Committee.
