



Memorandum of Understanding between EHC and EAHAD

Updated February 2024

This Memorandum of Understanding specifies the areas and modalities for collaboration between the European Haemophilia Consortium (EHC) and the European Association for Haemophilia and Allied Disorders (EAHAD).

Annual conferences

- EHC and EAHAD will each provide up to four complimentary registrations to the other organisation for their annual conferences.
- EHC and EAHAD will share with the other organisation their draft conference programmes with a view to finding synergies.

Joint meetings

 EHC and EAHAD will meet at least twice a year during their annual conferences and other relevant meetings (e.g. ISTH, WFH Congress) or online. The delegations will comprise of the two associations' leadership members, as well as relevant secretariat office members.

Areas of collaboration

- EHC and EAHAD will communicate on advocacy issues and collaborate as relevant.
- EHC and EAHAD will communicate on data collection and collaborate as relevant.
- EAHAD will nominate clinicians to review EHC-collected data when requested.
- EAHAD will involve the EHC in any revision of the European Principles of Haemophilia Care.
- EHC and EAHAD will collaborate on joint initiatives.
