From Schiphol Airport

Train & Metro

The **Train & Metro** is the most efficient route to the workshop venue and will take approximately 30 minutes:

- From Schiphol you take the train to **Amsterdam Central Station**
- From there you take any Metro line to **Wibautstraat Station**
- Take exit “Gijsbrecht van Aemstelstraat”, make a u-turn and you will see Volkshotel on your left.

The train runs day and night every day of the week. One ticket costs €5.50 and can be purchased at the ticket machines in the station or online [here](#). A single-use Metro ticket costs €2.90 and is available to purchase at every station – Make sure to activate your ticket at the beginning of your journey and check-out at the end of your journey.





Taxi

You can opt to take a taxi at your own expense* if you wish.

Follow the signs for the taxi rank at Airport Arrivals.

The journey will cost approximately €40-€50 and take around 20 minutes (depending on traffic).

*Please note that the taxi costs will be reimbursed only in case of late arrivals (after 21.00) or in case of mobility restraints.
